

Re-application Requirements

for
La Jolla Rotary and Florence Riford Scholarships

Additional scholarship funds may be available for prior recipients of either La Jolla Rotary or Florence Riford Scholarships (although there is no assurance as to whether a scholarship will be awarded, and if so, the amount of the scholarship). Re-applications will be considered only for undergraduates, and only for the first four academic years after high school (i.e. no scholarships will be awarded to fifth or sixth year students). In order for the La Jolla Rotary Scholarship Committee to consider your re-application, we must have received from you both of the following:

1. A letter from you, requesting additional scholarship funds, and telling us something about what you are doing in college and why you are worthy of further scholarship assistance. This letter must also include your current mailing address, e-mail address and phone number.

2a. La Jolla Rotary Scholarship: A certified transcript from a four-year college or university which includes your grades from your most recently completed term, and which reflects a cumulative GPA of at least 3.5.

2b. Florence Riford Scholarship: A certified transcript from a four-year California college or university, which sets forth all of the following: confirmation that you are majoring in math, science, engineering, or pre-medicine (or, if you have not yet declared a major, that your course work is focused on one or more of these areas), your grades from your most recently completed term, and a cumulative GPA of at least 3.5.

To reemphasize, all reapplication materials must have been received by the La Jolla Rotary Scholarship Committee on or before the deadline specified in the La Jolla Rotary Scholarships Program homepage or your scholarship reapplication will not be considered . . . no exceptions.

No interviews are conducted in connection with re-application scholarships. Rather, to be considered for a re-application scholarship, all that is required is the timely submission the re-applicant's letter and certified transcript (as specified above). Scholarship Committee decisions concerning re-application scholarships normally are announced by May 15, and are communicated via email; to ensure that these emails are received, re-applicants are encouraged to check their email inboxes carefully, set their spam filters and check their spam periodically.
